Mark's quote – a compound and attributes it to Isaiah, the 'larger' written prophet...

### John the Baptist

- A Man 'sent from God John 1:6
- Message a message from God "the word of God came to John" Luke 3:2

Preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins – Mark 1:4

### John's baptism

- A baptism
- In water
- For the forgiveness of sins
- Accompanied by repentance!
  - Matt. 3:5-9

#### Baptism of repentance for the remission of sins – Mark 1:4; Luke 3:3;

A baptism that required repentance as a 'prerequisite' –

Note John's response to the Pharisees... Matt. 3:5-9

For the remission of sins – sins had separated, this God's word about reconciliation.

# TWO responses

when all the people and the tax collectors heard this, they acknowledged God's justice, having been baptized with the baptism of John.

30 But the Pharisees and the lawyers *rejected God's* purpose for themselves, not having been baptized by John.

### Jesus' challenge to the Pharisees Mark 11:27-32

"John's baptism, was if from heaven or from men? ANSWER ME."

They began reasoning among themselves, saying, "If we say, 'From heaven,' He will say, 'Then why did you not believe him?'

- John was God's messenger
- John's message was God's message
- John's baptism was 'God's baptism'

To reject – is to reject GOD

### **Commission of Jesus**

- make disciples, baptizing them...
  - Matt. 28:18-19
- included repentance
  - Luke 24:44-46
- promised salvation
  - Mark 16:15-16

### In Acts 10:47-48

- Baptism in water
- Baptism in the name of Jesus
- Baptism COMMANDED

### In Acts 2:38

- Baptism in name of Jesus
- Accompanied by Repentance
- For remission of sins

### Response?

- As many as received the word were baptized... vs. 41
- MANY religious people rejected the word, rejected baptism, rejected Jesus
