- Christ came as God's better sacrificial lamb to atone for His peoples sins
- Hebrews 10:1-4, 9-10, 11-13

John 1:29

- The Passover Lamb
 - Exodus 12:5-7,15-17
 - Lamb offered instead of the firstborn
Exodus 12:21-24
 - Saved them from the wrath of God
Exodus 12:13
 - Stood as a memorial Exodus 12:26-27

The Lamb of God

John 1:29

- Our Passover Lamb **1 Cor. 5:7**
- The better sacrifice
1 Peter 3:18; Matt. 20:28
- Its cleansing is available daily
1 John 1:7; Heb. 7:25
- He saves us from the wrath of God
Rom. 5:9

Not an accident Paul calls Jesus our Passover here in 1 Cor. 5:7

Passover lamb – not a sin offering. Christ new Passover offering was!

Unleavened bread - Later leaven came to symbolize the evil influence of sin that must be purged away (Matt. 16:6; 1 Cor. 5:6-8). Thus the unleavened bread represents the broken body of our sinless Savior.

The Lamb of God

John 1:29

- The Lord's Supper **Luke 22:19-20**
 - Bread –Reminds us of the pure life lived
 - Fruit of the vine – Reminds us of the blood necessary for my pardon **Eph. 1:7**
- Some Applications:
 - Shall I treat the Lord's Supper as the Israelites treated the Passover? **1 Cor. 11:27-28**
 - Approach the Lord's Supper as if it is your very first time
