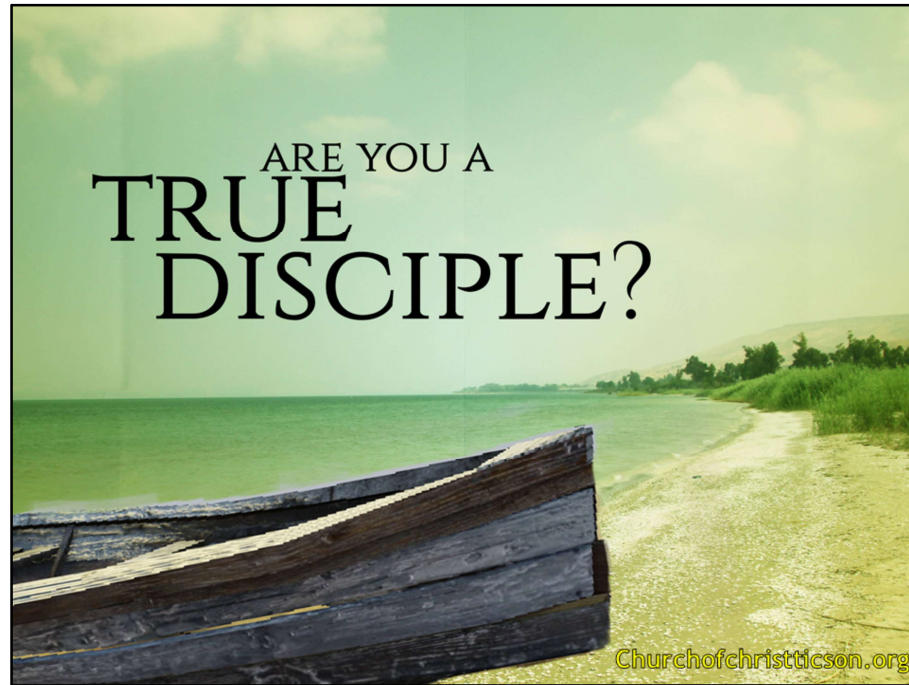

Are You A True Disciple?

- ▶ Before Christ's followers were called Christians they were known as disciples **Acts 11:26**
- ▶ "Disciple" appears 260 times in the Gospels and Acts
- ▶ Disciple is more than just a student **Luke 9:23-26**

Disciple - It refers to someone who takes up the ways of someone else. Applied to Jesus, a disciple is someone who learns from him to live like him.

Are You A True Disciple?

- ▶ Are you a true disciple?
- ▶ There are many fake disciples
Mark 7:6-8; Matt. 7:21-23
- ▶ The goal is to be more like
Jesus not less **Matt. 10:24-25**

Are You A True Disciple?

- ▶ The marks of a true disciple
 - ▶ Learns from his master
John 8:31-32; Matt. 11:28-30
 - ▶ Obeys his master
John 8:31-32, 39; James 1:22-25
 - ▶ Denies himself
Luke 14:26-27 cf. Matt. 16:21ff
 - ▶ Loves Jesus' other disciples
John 13:35
 - ▶ Bears fruit John 15:8 (vv.4-5)
