

- •40+ authors over 1600 years
- •Doctrinal Unity:
 - High View of Marriage Genesis 20:2-7;
 Hebrews 13:4; Matthew 19:10
 - Not altering God's word Deuteronomy 4:2;
 Proverbs 30:6; Revelation 22:19
- Organic Unity
- Unity in Style
 - Incredibly streamlined John 21:25; 2 Peter 1:21

Organic unity – "Any part of the human body can only be properly explained in reference to the whole body. And any part of the Bible can only be properly explained in reference to the whole Bible."

Style – Any human writer, relying upon his own inspiration, would have written volumes concerning the creation, what God was doing before creation, the flood, the birth, life and death of Jesus, etc.

It is very brief and to the point. Very matter of fact in all of its accounts.

Prophecy:

- Isaiah 53
 - "Despised and rejected" John 7:5, 48
 - "By His scourging..." Matthew 27:26
 - "Yet with a rich man" Matthew 27:57-60
- •Just three of over 300 predictive prophecies in the Old Testament
 - The odds of one person to fulfill just <u>8</u> messianic prophecies is 1 in 10¹⁷
 - The odds of one person fulfilling $\underline{48}$ of them is 1 in 10^{157}

The LXX (Greek OT) was completed in 250 B.C. So you had the whole Old Testament cannon completed at some point before 250 B.C.


