

The Days of Matthew 24:

- The Context:
 - Matthew 21: Kingdom taken from the Jewish leaders (vv.43-45).
 - Matthew 23:29-39
 - Mistreated the prophets. v.34
 - This generation will not escape.
 - Upon them was the blood of the prophets. v.35
 - Upon that generation. v.36
 - Their house left desolate. v.38

The Days of Matthew 24:

- The Timetable:
 - Matthew 24:34 "This generation."
 - Setting for the discussion
 Matthew 24:1-3:
 - Look how great the temple is!
 - It's going to be destroyed.
 - When is that going to happen?
 - Don't misread the signs
 Matthew 24:4b-8

Matthew 24 is the answer Jesus gives to the disciples' question about the destruction of the temple and by extension Jerusalem.



The Days of Matthew 24:

- The Destruction of Jerusalem:
 - The Gospel first must be preached
 Matthew 24:9-14 (Colossians 1:23)
 - The Abomination of Desolation
 Matthew 24:15-28 (Luke 21:20-21)
 - The Sign of Judgement
 Matthew 24:29-31
 (Isaiah 13:6-11; Joel 2:28-32)
 - Will Happen to That Generation
 Matthew 24:32-35
