- Approaching the Most Holy:
 - Leviticus 16:2
 - Before the presence of God.
 - No trivial appointment!
 - Detailed conditions on approaching Jehovah. (Lev. 8; 16:2-4)
 - When neglected it resulted in deadly consequences. Leviticus 10:1-3
- Christ has permanently fulfilled those conditions and given us access to God! Hebrews 4:14-16; 10:12, 19-22

- The Centurions Daughter Luke 7:2-10:
 - vv.2-5: Jewish Elders are sent to Jesus
 - He is worthy to have his servant healed!
 - He built us a synagogue.
 - vv.6-10: Centurions Servant is sent to Jesus.
 - Centurion "I am not worthy."
- Lesson: None of us are worthy to approach God.

- The Pharisee and the Tax Collector Luke 18:9-14:
 - vv.11-12: Mr. Holier-Than-Thou
 - v.13: Would not even raise his head.
 - v.14: The lesson from Jesus.
- Lesson: God desires a humble heart in order to approach Him. 1 Peter 5:5-7

- Blind Bartimaeus Luke 18:35-43:
 - vv.35-36: Jesus approaching and Bartimaeus wanting to know.
 - w.37-39: Understands his condition and stops at nothing to get to Jesus.
 - vv.40-43: Jesus moved with compassion heals the man.
- Lesson: God desires those who will stop at nothing to come to Him.

- Bringing it Together: Who may approach God?
- It is not those who:
 - Believe themselves worthy.
 (The elders' appraisal of the Centurion)
 - Are self righteous. (The Pharisee)
 - Would not permit another to come.
- It is those who:
 - Know their condition.
 - Know they are seeking an all righteous God.
 - Will stop at nothing to come to Him.
