

- A Psalm of David. A Maskil.
 - Maskil = "giving instruction."
 - It is a teaching Psalm. Colossians 3:16
 - The Psalm has a lesson and application.
- Forgiveness is a Blessing vv.1-2
 - Happy is the one whose sins are removed!
 - Happy is the one who God does not charge and convict as guilty.

Isaiah 53:4-5; 1 John 1:7, 9

- •The Consequence of Sin and the Relief of God:
 - The consequence of my sins:
 - My body wasted away. v.3
 - This is the Lord's doing. v.4
 - Done for a purpose. 2 Corinthians 7:8-10
 - I went to the Lord:
 - I acknowledge my sin to God. v.5a
 - God forgave me. v.5b

- Seek Forgiveness While It Is Available: vv.6-7
 - Because God is gracious to forgive, do not be slow in seeking it! v.6a
 - Don't wait! v.6b
 - God is merciful, why would we delay in coming to Him? v.7

- Making Good Use of Forgiveness: vv.8-11
 - I will teach others.
 v.8 cf. Psalm 51:12-13
 - Warning against stubbornness.
 vv.9-10a
 - Trust in God and receive the blessings.
 v.10b-11
