## The Joy of Knowing Christ: Philippians 3

• Paul's Temporary Joy (vv.1-6): • "Rejoice in the Lord." (V.1) • Our joy needs to be sourced from Christ. • Any other source will be a temporary joy. Hebrews 11:25 (cf. Ecclesiastes) • Don't Trust in the Flesh. (vv.2-3) Trusting in the flesh = thinking lasting joy can be had without God. • "Had I been happy without Jesus, I never would have turned to Him" (Randy Alcorn). • Paul's Pursuits. (vv.4-6)

## The Joy of Knowing Christ: Philippians 3

- Where True Joy Comes From (vv.7-11)
  - But... (v.7)
    - Whatever Paul had, whatever joys, their true value was known the moment when Paul was confronted with Christ.
  - Knowing Jesus (v.8)
    - He counted everything as rubbish in comparison.
    - Matthew 16:25
  - What Jesus Offers (vv.9-11)
    - John 10:9-10

## The Joy of Knowing Christ: Philippians 3

- True Joy is Worth Everything (vv.12-21)
  - Press on! (vv.12-16)
    - All that Christ offers is worth the race, the effort, the struggle of this life!
    - Hebrews 12:1-2
  - Follow our example and rejoice. (vv.17-21)
    - Just as those before us, for the joy set before them, pressed on, we press on for that same joy.
    - The joy of Christ is worth my all.
