- What is a Deacon?
  - Diakonos Servant, attendant, or waiter.
  - Translated two ways
    - Minister Colossians 1:25
    - Servant Matthew 20:26
  - All Christians are to be servants. Colossians 4:7; 1 Corinthians 3:5

• There is an official office in the local church of Deacon. 1 Timothy 3:8, 12; Philippians 1:1

- Who May Serve as a Deacon?
  - The character portrait of a Deacon (1 Timothy 3:8-12).
    - Men of dignity. 1 Timothy 4:12
    - Not double tongued. James 3:9-10
    - Sober in all things.
    - Not greedy for money.
    - Stable in his faith. Ephesians 4:14
    - First be tested.

- Who May Serve as a Deacon?
  - The character portrait of a Deacon (1 Timothy 3:8-12).
    - Beyond reproach. Titus 2:7-8
    - Of one wife. 1 Timothy 3:12
    - Good mangers of their households.
      Joshua 24:15; Ephesians 6:4
    - Their wives must also be of good Christian character.
      1 Timothy 3:11

- •What Is a Deacons Work?
  - Deacons, in contrast to Elders, do not have their work detailed in Scripture.
  - Elders are given the responsibility of leading (Acts 20:28; 1 Peter 5:2).
  - •What then is their work?
    - It's in the name, servant.
    - •Acts 6:1-6 as a type.
