 Ephesians 1:15-23 (esp. 19)
 - This power is experienced first in conversion.
 1 Corinthians 6:14
 - We continue to experience as we grow in our knowledge and understanding. Ephesians 1:17-18

 - We need the armor of God.
 - Not armor made by God, but God's very own armor.
 - Belt of truth Isaiah 11:5
 - Breastplate and helmet Isaiah 59:17
 - The boots of the Gospel Isaiah 52:7
 - God is a shield Genesis 15:1
 - The Messiah wields the sword of His mouth Isaiah 49:1-2

 - We get glimpses throughout Scripture:
 - The Angel in Daniel 10:12-14, 20.
 - The war in heaven when Christ was crucified and resurrected. Revelation 12:7-8.
