- •An Eye for An Eye (Matt. 5:38-42):
 - Tradition: Vengeance is mine saith me.
 - •V.38 quotes the law the Pharisees would cite. (Cf. Ex. 21:24; Lev. 24:20; Deut. 19:21).
 - What God said. Lev. 19:17-18; 24:20
 - I say unto you. Matt. 5:39-42



LOVING YOUR ENEMIES:

MATTHEW 5:38-48

- Love Your Neighbor (Matt. 5:43-45):
 - Tradition: Love only those who love you.
 - •V.43 quotes Lev. 19:18.
 - Second part is found nowhere in the law.
 - God's standard: love your enemies (Matt. 5:44)
 - •Vengeance has no place in our lives.
 - Lk. 6:27-31; Rom. 12:14, 17-21
 - This is a love of the will. 1 John4:19



LOVING YOUR ENEMIES:

MATTHEW 5:38-48

- Sons and Daughters of The Father (Matt. 5:45-48):
 - •We love because God loves. Matt. 5:45
 - We love our enemies because God loved us while we were His enemies.

Rom. 5:6-8; Lk. 23:34

- •We are called to a higher standard. Matt. 5:46-47
- •We are to be like our Father. Matt. 5:48; Lev. 19:2
