Baptism in God's Plan of Salvation:

- Salvation is Conditional:
 - Condition(s) is defined as "set prior requirements on (something) before it can occur or be done."
 - Conditions to salvation is nothing new. Heb. 11:7
 - What conditions has God placed for salvation?
 - Faith. Jn. 3:16; 8:24; Heb. 11:6
 - Repentance. Lk. 13:3
 - Confession. Matt. 10:32-33; Rom. 10:9-10
 - Baptism. Matt. 28:19; Mk. 16:16

- Baptism and ...
 - The Scriptures connect each condition of salvation with baptism at some point.
 - Faith and baptism are connected to salvation.
 Mk. 16:16
 - Repentance and baptism are connected to salvation.
 Acts 2:38
 - Confession and baptism are connected to salvation.
 Acts 8:36-38
 - Salvation and baptism are connected together. 1 Pet. 3:21

Baptism in God's Plan of Salvation:

- Connecting It All Together:
 - We are responding in <u>faith</u> in God's command when we are baptized. Acts 8:12-13
 - We are committing fully to our <u>repentance</u> when we are baptized by crucifying our old life of sin. Rom. 6:3-7
 - We are <u>confessing</u> Christ as Lord and Savior when we are baptized. 1 Pet. 3:21
 - When we are baptized, we are clothed with Christ, washed in His blood, cleansed from our sins, and have new life.
