The Godhead

Acts 17:24-29

- There Is One God:

- ◆ Hebrew word **yachiyd** means “solitary in number” (Strong’s).

- This word never applied to God.

- ◆ Hebrew word **‘echad** denotes unity, acting as one (Mounce).

The Godhead

Acts 17:24-29

- There Is One God:

- ◆ Hebrew word 'echad denotes unity, acting as one (Mounce).

- Of man and woman becoming one flesh.

Gen. 2:24

- It can sometimes refer to one of a group.

Gen. 2:21

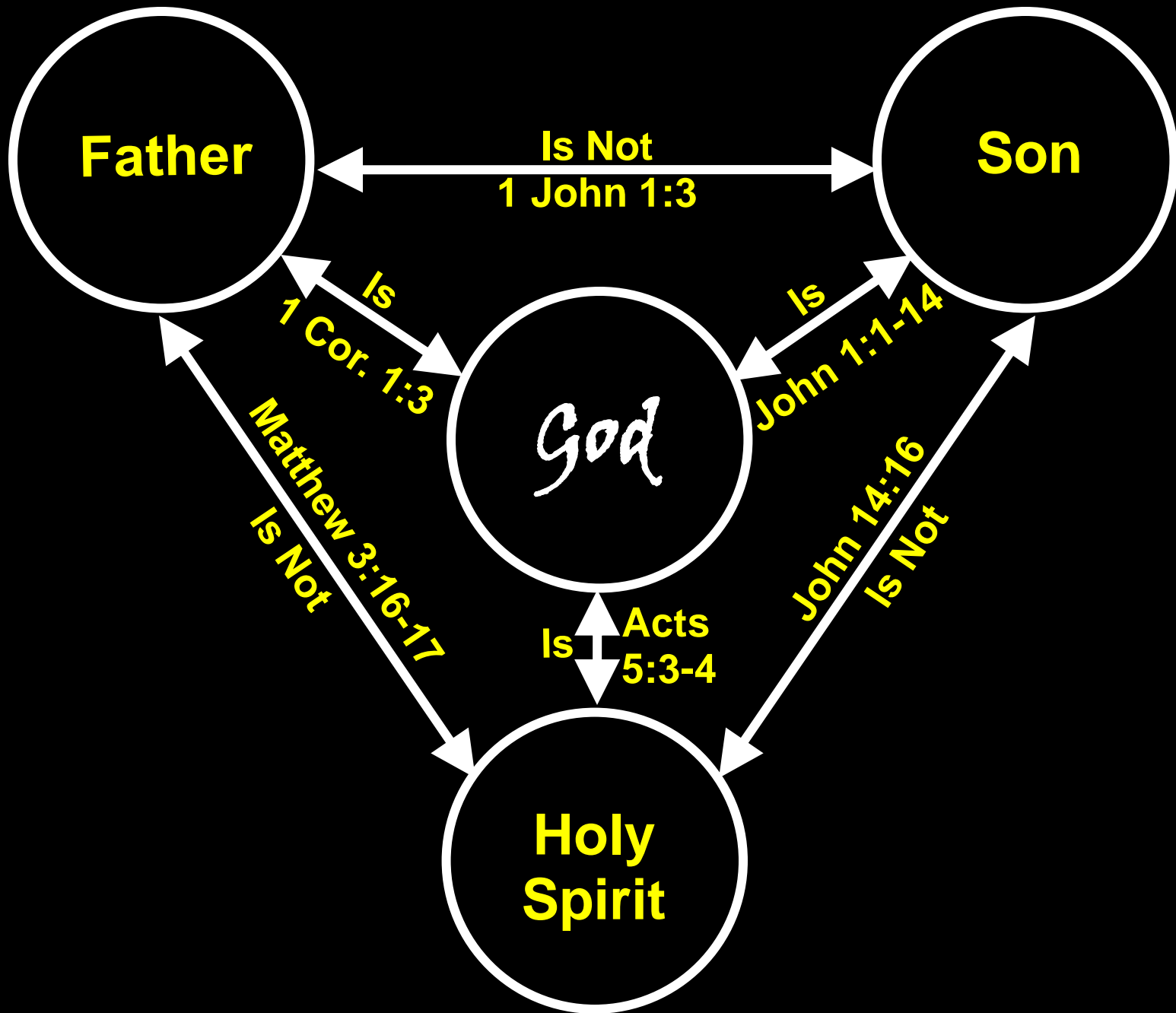
- Single purpose. **2 Chron. 30:12**

- This is the word applied to God. **Deut. 6:4**

The Godhead

Acts 17:24-29

- God in Three Persons:
 - ◆ Each Member of the Godhead is called God.
John 6:27; Col. 2:8-9; Acts 5:3-4
 - ◆ Each are addressed equally in salutations.
Rom. 1:7; Gal. 1:3
 - ◆ Each addressed equally in prayer.
2 Cor. 13:14
 - ◆ Jesus and the Father are one. **John 10:30**



The Godhead

Acts 17:24-29

- Unity in Work:

- ◆ Each member has a different role or function. **Heb. 12:9; Eph. 5:23; Jn. 16:13**
- ◆ United in creation.
Gen. 1:26; 1-2; Col. 1:15-16; Job 33:4
- ◆ Salvation.
Eph. 3:5-7; Matt. 28:18-20
