

- No One to Answer Saul:
 - The Philistines are preparing for war.
 - 1 Sam. 28:1
 - No one is left to answer Saul.
 - 1 Sam. 28:1-3, 6
 - Saul is left terrified.
 - 1 Sam. 28:5

- The Spiritual Life of Kings:
 - Kings were supposed to be good Bible students. Deut. 17:18-20
 - Leadership is not for those of weak faith. Josh. 1:7-9
 - This is also true of New Testament leadership. 1 Tim. 3:6; Titus 1:9

- Seek The Lord While He May Be Found:
 - Saul will "make himself" sin in order to find out what God wants.
 - 1 Sam. 28:3, 7 (cf. Lev. 19:31)
 - Shocked that it worked.
 - 1 Sam. 28:12-14
 - You already know what God has said.
 - 1 Sam. 28:15-19, 20; 31:2-6

- What Do We Learn from The Whole of Saul's Life?
 - It is a dangerous thing to rely on other people for our faith.
 - The time to serve the Lord is always now.
 - **Luke 13:6-9**
