5:16 But Jesus Himself would *often* slip away to the wilderness and pray.

3:21-22 But Jesus Himself would *often* slip away to the wilderness and pray.

→ 6:11



HE PRAYED

- 6:11 – enemies Rage

Prayed

- 6:13 – Chose aposels

Between enemies raging against Him (6:11), and choosing apostles (6:13) ---
6:12 It was at this time that He went off to the mountain to pray, and He spent the whole night in prayer to God. (6:12)



HE PRAYED

- 9:18
- 9:28-29

9:18 And it happened that while He was praying alone, the disciples were with Him, and He questioned them, saying, "Who do the people say that I am?"

9:28-29 ²⁸Some eight days after these sayings, He took along Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. ²⁹And while He was praying, the appearance of His face became different, and His clothing *became white and* gleaming.



GIVING THANKS

- 9:16
- 24:30
- 22:17-19

9:16 Then He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed them, and broke *them*, and kept giving *them* to the disciples to set before the people.

24:30 When He had reclined *at the table* with them, He took the bread and blessed *it*, and breaking *it*, He *began* giving *it* to them.

22:17-19 ¹⁷ And when He had taken a cup *and* given thanks, He said, "Take this and share it among yourselves; ¹⁸ for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine from now on until the kingdom of God comes." ¹⁹ And when He had taken *some* bread *and* given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

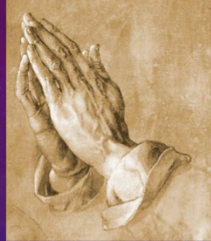
Facing Crucifixion – 22:40-46

⁴⁰ When He arrived at the place, He said to them, "Pray that you may not enter into temptation." ⁴¹ And He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and He knelt down and *began* to pray

⁴² saying, "Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Yours be done." ⁴³ Now an angel from heaven appeared to Him, strengthening Him. And being in agony He was praying very fervently; and His sweat became like drops of blood, falling down upon the ground.

⁴⁵ When He rose from prayer, He came to the disciples and found them sleeping from sorrow,

⁴⁶ and said to them, "Why are you sleeping? Get up and pray that you may not enter into temptation."
