 –Like Paul and Peter, Jeremiah and Nehemiah, Hannah and Esther, Abraham

 Should encourage us to give our full devotion to prayer –Like Jesus Christ, our Lord -His pattern • Luke 3:21; 4:42; 5:16; 6:12; 9:18; 9:28; 11:1; 22:39

- James 5:16-18
  - –Effective, fervent prayer by a righteous man avails much
  - –Elijah, a man with a nature like ours

-His prayers impacted God's providential manipulation of nature

- Luke 18:1-8
  - -Pray and not lose heart
  - -Widow represents God's own elect
  - –We can affect God's ruling in this world!

- Examples of righteous prayers who did not change God's decision
  - Paul 2 Corinthians 12:7-10Jesus Matthew 26:36-44

- Some lessons learned
  - -God has chosen that the prayers of His faithful disciples can affect His decisions!
  - -He has demonstrated that He will respond to their prayers

 Some lessons learned -He has responded both miraculously and providentially -If we truly believe these things, surely we will be more intense and continual in our prayers!!
