 - In the midst of a crooked and perverse generation.
 - Harmless (Unmixed)
 - Without blemish (Undamaged)
 - And hold fast!!

Christians as Citizens of the USA Philippians 3:20-21

- Citizenship in heaven
 - Colossians 1:13-14
 - Earthly citizenship remains unchanged
 - Acts 22:25-28 Paul remained a Roman citizen after he became a Christian

Christians as Citizens of the USA Philippians 3:20-21

- As citizens under earthly governments
 - Christians are instructed to live in a way that reflects the spiritual principles of Christ.
 - Matthew 5:14-16

Christians as Citizens of the USA Philippians 3:20-21

- As Christians
 - Principles by which we must live
 - Matthew 22:21 "Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's"
 - Romans 13:1-7; 1 Peter 2:13-14 Submission to laws and authority
 - Acts 4:18-20; 5:28-32 Must obey God rather than men

- What does "Render to Caesar" mean in the USA?
 - "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness ..."
 - "...that to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed ..." (Declaration of Independence – July 4, 1776)

- What does "Render to Caesar" mean in the USA?
 - Our government was founded on the principle that those who are governed would be active participants
 - Giving their consent through elected representatives
 - Exercising their freedoms as described in the Bill of Rights.

- What does "Render to Caesar" mean in the USA?
 - This governing authority, as all others, is appointed by God – Romans 13:1
 - This governing authority expects its citizens to participate by electing representatives at the local, state and federal level.

- What does "Render to Caesar" mean in the USA?
 - Elected representatives fill positions in the executive, legislative and, in some cases, judicial branches of the government.
 - Other judicial positions are filled by appointment by executive and/or legislative representatives.

- What does "Render to Caesar" mean in the USA?
 - These representatives make, enforce and interpret the laws at all levels of government.

- What does "Render to Caesar" mean in the USA?
 - The result of this governmental system "of the people, by the people, and for the people" is a system that has provided unparalleled freedoms for its citizens.
 - What is expected of a Christian?

- Participate by Voting
 - Our God-ordained system expects citizens to elect those who govern
 - Go to the voting booth as a Christian! Do your research.
 - Support candidates who take godly stands on moral issues.

- Pray fervently
 - 1 Timothy 2:1-4
 - Proverbs 14:34 "Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people."
 - Psalms 33:10-22

- Pray fervently
 - 1 Timothy 6:15-16 Sovereign, King of kings
 - Revelation 8:3-5 Prayers of saints
 - God has so established and circumscribed His rule that the prayers of believers can impact His rule!

- Pray fervently
 - Examples of men & women of faith
 - Luke 18:1-8
 - Her continual coming changed the judge's mind!
 - Jeremiah 18:6-10 The Potter will change His mind!

- Pray fervently
 - **Jeremiah 18:6-10**
 - The Potter will change His mind!

- Let our light shine on moral issues
 - **Ephesians 5:10-12**
 - Our Lord does not call us to be political or social activists, but we are to be lights in the darkness!

- Let our light shine on moral issues
 - **Ephesians 5:10-12**
 - Abortion
 - Sacred Selections
 - In a godly way show a better way
 - Provide for adoption

- Recent actions relative to abortion
 - January 2012 Ruling from the US Department of Health and Human Services
 - Required employers (profit and non-profit) to provide health care plans that include coverage of abortifacients (drugs or agents that cause abortions).

- Let our light shine on moral issues
 - **Ephesians 5:10-12**
 - Abortion
 - General morality
 - Sanctity of marriage
 - Pornography
