MICAH:

- **All we know about the prophet comes from vv. 1**
- **From Moresheth**
- **Name means “who is like Jehovah?”**
- **Prophet of Judah**
- **Contemporaries with Hosea and Isaiah (between 750 and 686 BC)**

GOD'S CASE:

- **Prophecy takes place *before* captivity**
- **Ch. I is the beginning of God's case against His people**
- **Guilty of:**
 - **Idolatry/ Spiritual harlotry**
 - **Judges 2:17**
- **Micah's Response vv.8-16**

WOE TO OPPRESSORS:

- **Micah 2:**
 - **God outlines the abuses that are happening in the kingdom**
 - **It will be an unescapable judgment vv. 1-5**
 - **They oppress and silence God's prophets vv. 6-11**
 - **A spark of hope vv. 12-13**

RULERS CONDEMNED:

- **Micah 3:**
 - **Micah calls out the wickedness of the leaders vv. 1-4**
 - **Wickedness of the “prophets” and priest vv.5-7**
 - **Micah is contrasted vv.8**
 - **The condemnation of the leaders, priest and prophets vv. 9-12**
