

Therefore since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.



What makes Jesus this great high priest?




"The presence of a "priesthood" has been characteristic of virtually every society of cultured man since the beginning of time." – Wayne Jackson

Fitting (πρέπω/ prepo)

- to be suitable or proper (third person singular present indicative, often used impersonally, it is fit or right): — become, comely.



Melchizedek's Priesthood – It is like Christ in that it is a special priesthood. It only exist for that person. It does not continue. Melchizedek had no "priestly-family," his priesthood did not continue. Christ has a priesthood forever.
