- Can We Know God?
 - What does it mean to know someone or something?
 - “Have developed a relationship with (someone) through meeting and spending time with them; be familiar or friendly with”
 - “To perceive or understand as fact or truth; to apprehend clearly and with certainty”

TO KNOW GOD

JEREMIAH 31:34

- Can We Know God?
 - What does it mean to know someone or something?
 - We can *know* God, but only on His terms.
Isaiah 40:28; Deuteronomy 29:29
 - That is by revelation:
 - Natural **Romans 1:20**
 - Supernatural **2 Timothy 3:16**

TO KNOW GOD

JEREMIAH 31:34

- Knowing *about* vs. *knowing*:
 - I must know something *about* a person or a thing if I am to *know* that person or thing.
 - I can know about something and not *know* it
 - Example: I know a lot about Homer Hailey, but I can never *know* him.
- Knowing about is where I start in order to *know* God.


