- What does faithfulness mean?
 - Faithfulness same family of words as faith, faithful, faithless, etc.
 - That which is dependable, trustworthy, can be counted on.
 - Used repeatably of God.
 1 John 1:9; Heb. 10:23; 1 Cor. 10:13

What does faithfulness mean?
Daniel as an example. Daniel 6:4

 To Be Faithful is, to Be Honest: Daniel was honest. Dan. 6:4 God hates dishonesty. **Prov. 6:16-19; John 14:6** The faithful person is to be honest in all things. Eph. 4:25; Luke 16:10

To Be Faithful is, to Be Dependable:
Again, Daniel's example. Dan. 6:4, 1-2.
God's standard of dependability. Ps. 15:1-2, 4

- To Be Faithful is, to Be Loyal:
 - Not a blind loyalty that sees no faults.
 - Loyalty that tells the truth. Prov. 27:6, 5

 - 3. Give serious thought to how you can improve.
