The Roman Centurion Luke 7:1-10:

- vv.2-5: Jewish Elders are sent to Jesus
 - He is worthy to have his servant healed!
 - He built us a synagogue.
- vv.6-10: Centurions Servant is sent to Jesus.
 - Centurion "I am <u>not</u> worthy."
- Lesson: None of us are worthy to approach God (Matthew 5:3).

The Pharisee and the Tax Collector Luke 18:9-14:

- vv.11-12: Mr. Holier-Than-Thou.
- v.13: Would not even raise his head.
- v.14: The lesson from Jesus.
- Lesson: God desires a humble heart in order to approach Him. 1 Peter 5:5-7

Blind Bartimaeus Luke 18:35-43:

- vv.35-36: Jesus approaching and Bartimaeus wanting to know.
- vv.37-39: Understands his condition and stops at nothing to get to Jesus.
- vv.40-43: Jesus moved with compassion heals the man.
- Lesson: God desires those who will stop at nothing to come to Him.

It is not those who:

- Believe themselves worthy.
 (The elders' appraisal of the Centurion)
- Are self righteous. (The Pharisee)
- Would not permit another to come (The crowd).

It is those who:

- Know their condition (Matthew 5:3).
- Seek God in humility.
- Will stop at nothing to come to Him.
