Keep Away:

2 Thess. 3:6-18

- Keep Away from the Undisciplined (2 Thess. 3:6-13):
 - The command of church discipline. V.6
 - Walks in an unruly manner. 1 Jn. 1:6-7
 - Paul's example. 2 Thess. 3:7-13
 - Worked, provided for his own.
 - Some at Thessalonica. vv.10-11
 - They're admonished. V.12

Keep Away:

2 Thess. 3:6-18

- Keep Away from the Disobedient (2 Thess. 3:14):
 - We've moved far beyond Matthew 18:15-20.
 - Admonished publicly through this letter.
 - Repent or be marked and shunned.

Keep Away:

2 Thess. 3:6-18

- Admonish Him as a Brother (2 Thess. 3:15):
 - Reminder discipline does not mean they are now enemies. v.15
 - The goal of discipline is correction.
 Heb. 12:11
 - The heart of discipline is *love*.
