Acts 24:27; 25:23-27; 26:1-3
 - On trial for the hope of Israel.
vv.4-7 (Gen. 12:1-3; Gal. 3:23-24)
 - Why is it unbelievable if God does raise the dead? **v.8 (cf. 1 Cor. 15:1-11)**

 - 1. Many people we will talk with today are going to be like Festus and Felix.**
 - 2. We need to accept that sometimes we are going to be the only sane people in the room (**Acts 26:25**).**
 - 3. The best evidence for the risen Christ and the power of His gospel is the change in your life (**Acts 26:9, 19, 27-29**).**
